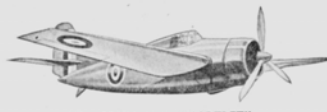


FLYIN' FOOL SCOUT

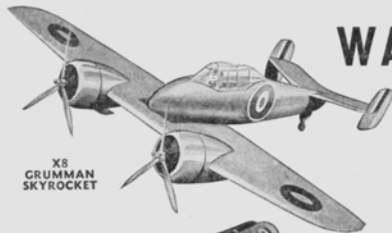

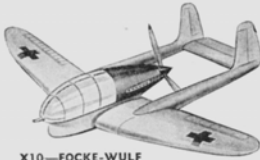

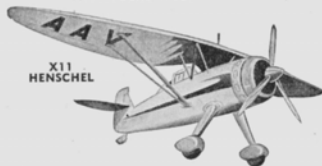

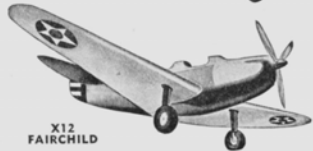

X9—WESTLAND "LYSANDER"—General purpose British fighter used in African campaign.

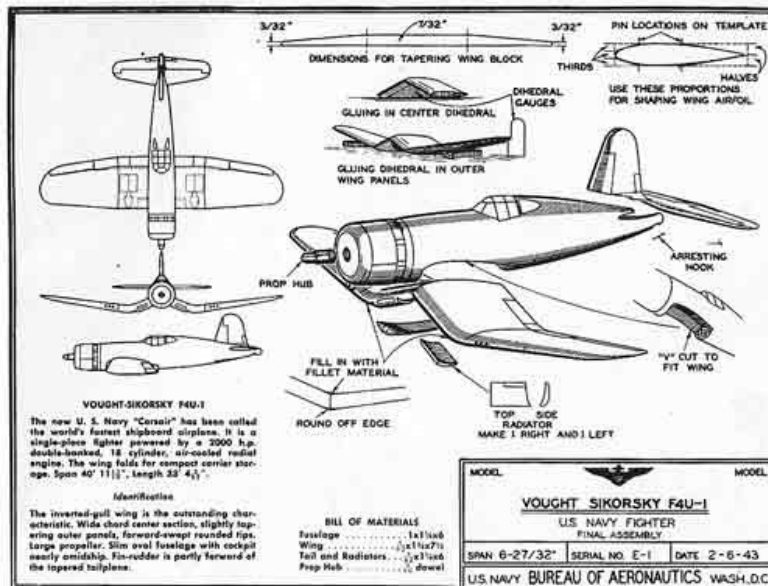
X10—FOCKE-WULF "FW 198"—One of Germany's newest fighter planes.
