# **FROM THE BOARD MEETING**. The following is a recap of the Board meeting on 1 December:

**ARMY DRONE DEMOS**. The US Army has inquired whether PGRC could host a series of demonstrations by vendors vying for an Army contract for a tethered drone system. The drone would carry a radio frequency (RF) repeater to extend the range of tactical communications, and would be tethered at an altitude of 100-200 feet. It seems that the demos could be orchestrated so they would not interfere with our members' RC flying at the field. Time frame for the demos would be early 2021. We will keep the membership informed as additional details are forthcoming.
